Indian Technical Economic Corporation (ITEC) has published notice about the program schedule and online application form in its website.

As per ITEC norms, the eligibility criteria for applying for ITEC courses are:-

- The age of the applicant must be 25 to 45 years.
- He/She must have minimum 5 years work experience.
- He/She must not be previous ITEC alumni.
