Indian Technical Economic Corporation (ITEC) has published notice about the program schedule and online application form in its website www.itecgoi.in. So, interested applicants who meet the eligibility criteria are requested to fill the online form in the website.

Instructions:

- Go to the link www.itecgoi.in
- Now in the search button search for institute name "Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research".
- Click on the link of the institute and click on Apply button for the course "Public Health Policy And Management Program- NPL".
- Select the nationality- Country Nepal and click on proceed button. Now fill in all the details and submit the form.

As per ITEC norms, the eligibility criteria for applying for ITEC courses are:-
